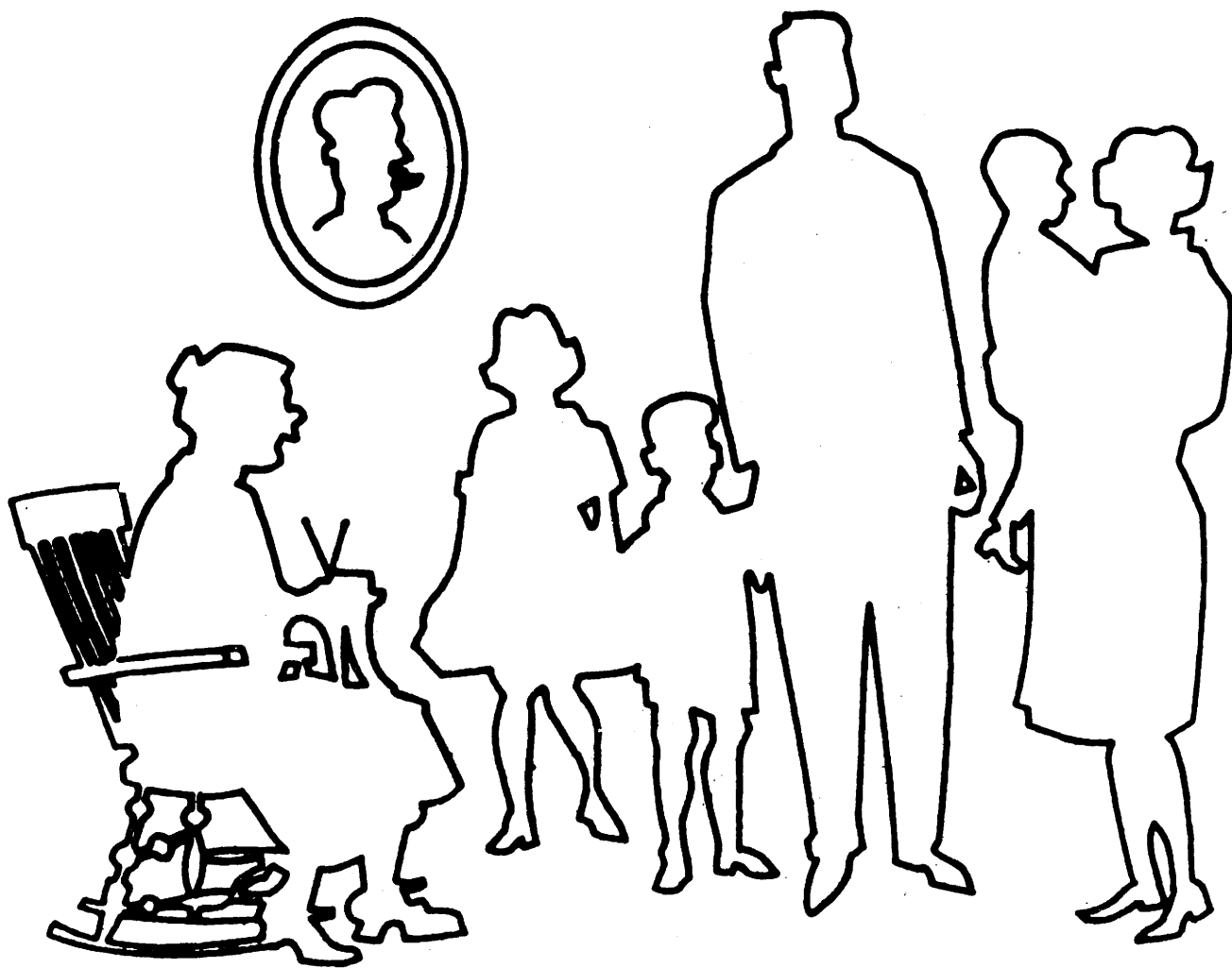

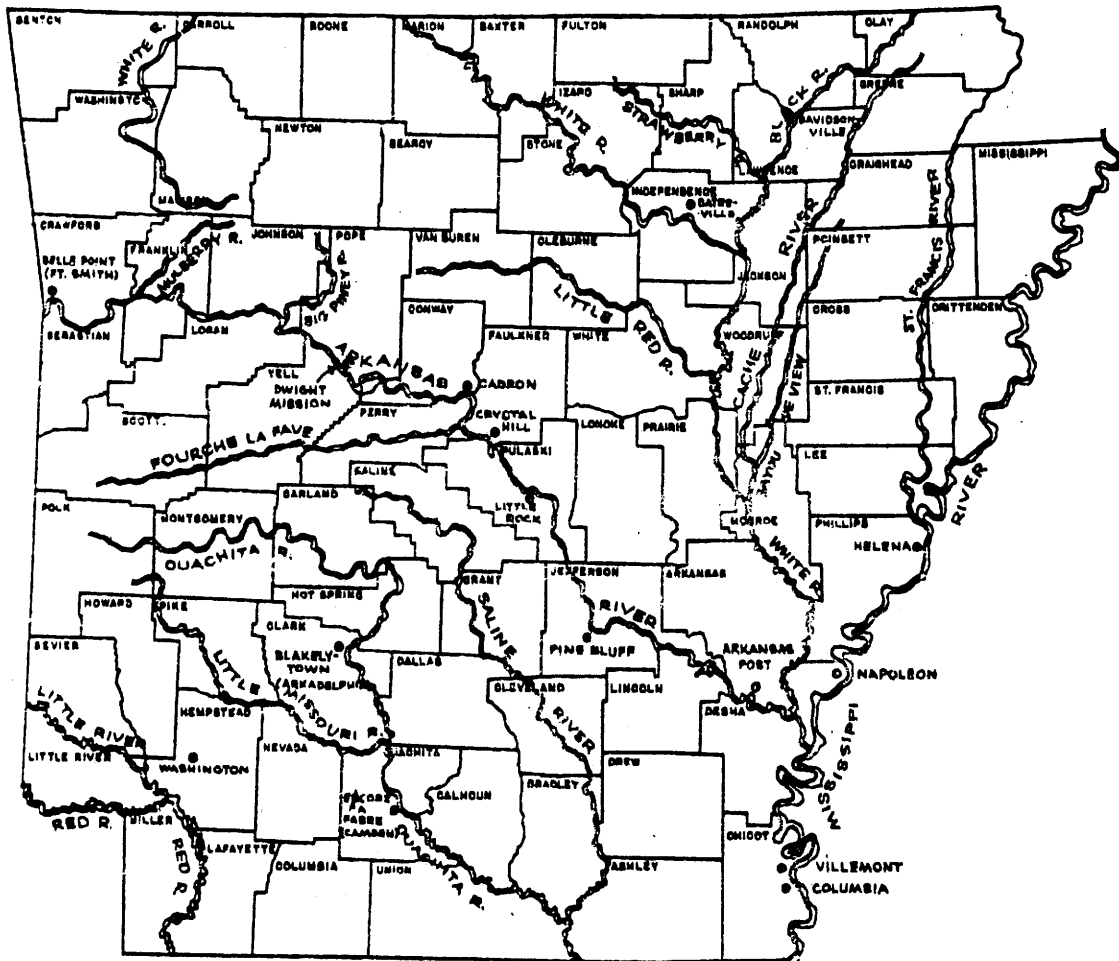

The 75 counties of Arkansas were for the most part given their official names in honor of some national or state leader who figured in the early peace or wartime history of the state and federal governments. However, several received their designations from the names of rivers, natural formations or in commemoration of the Declaration of Independence and the union of colonial states. Dates of their creation and distinguished men or highlights in history for which their counties were given their names was copied from an old newspaper (date unknown) but possibly the newspaper was the Arkansas Gazette, published in Little Rock, Arkansas.
